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Why Aberystwyth?

Founded in 1872 as the first university in Wales, Aberystwyth University is located on the west coast of Wales between the mountains and the sea. The University has received recognition for teaching quality and student experience and provides students with access to personal tutors, visa advice, wellbeing and financial support, alongside a wide range of clubs and societies.

Financial Support for International Students

Eligible international students may benefit from the University's International Accommodation Award. For 2026/27, the award varies by level of study and is subject to the University's current eligibility rules and specified accommodation arrangements.

Eligible international undergraduate students may receive a £2,000 tuition fee reduction for each year of study. For eligible taught master's applicants from specified countries, current postgraduate awards include £2,000 for an equivalent 2:1 or 2:2 and £3,000 for an equivalent First. Scholarship availability and eligibility should always be checked for the intended year of entry.

International undergraduate tuition fees are normally fixed for the duration of the course. International applicants may also be required to pay a tuition fee deposit. Where a deposit is required, the amount and payment arrangements are specified in the applicant's offer letter.

Courses, Intakes and Arrival

Aberystwyth offers foundation, undergraduate, taught postgraduate and research programmes across a broad range of subjects. September is the principal intake, with January entry available for selected programmes.

The University identifies Birmingham Airport as a convenient arrival point for international students and offers a Meet and Greet service on specified dates, subject to current arrangements. Birmingham and Aberystwyth are also connected by public transport.

Aberystwyth University offers international students programmes from foundation through to postgraduate research level in a distinctive coastal university environment. Financial support may include tuition fee scholarships and the International Accommodation Award, subject to eligibility and current terms.
