

Studying at Cyprus West University

Cyprus West University offers international students undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in Northern Cyprus. The podcast highlights its courses, tuition fees, scholarships, estimated living costs, academic calendar and student visa process.

Courses and Study Options

The podcast highlights programmes across engineering, business and social sciences, together with postgraduate study.

The podcast identifies these programmes as English-taught. Students should confirm the current language of instruction for their chosen programme before applying.

Academic Year

The podcast describes two main semesters and a summer school: Fall Semester from September to January, Spring Semester from January to June, and Summer School from June to September. Students should check the precise academic calendar for their intended year of study.

Tuition Fees, Scholarships and Living Costs

For 2026/27, the University publishes the following indicative international tuition fees and scholarships:

Study level	Published tuition	Published scholarship fee
Undergraduate	€6,500	€1,625 with 75% scholarship
MBA	€5,000	€2,500 with 50% scholarship

Scholarships are subject to current University eligibility and award conditions. Students should confirm the scholarship attached to their offer before making any financial commitment.

Living costs vary according to accommodation and lifestyle. The University currently gives an indicative figure of around €700 per month, but students should prepare an individual budget before travelling.

Student Visa and Arrival

Visa requirements vary by nationality. Some students may need to obtain a TRNC study visa before travelling, while others may receive permission to

enter at the port of entry. Students travelling through Türkiye may also require a Turkish transit visa. Current requirements should be checked before travel.

International students are responsible for completing the required student residence permit procedures after arrival and registration.
