Exploring Affordable International Study Options

Flexible Hybrid Pathways

Where available, students may also consider flexible or hybrid study pathways. Some programmes may allow part of the course to be completed online or in another location before the student completes the remaining study overseas.

Depending on the programme, this can provide greater flexibility and may reduce some of the overall costs associated with studying abroad. Students should check the structure, recognition and immigration implications of any hybrid programme before committing to it.

The emphasis is on balancing affordability, academic suitability and quality.
